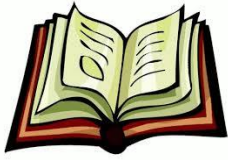




We hope that the weekly newsletters are useful and informative. On the annual questionnaire, parents asked to be regularly informed of events and the newsletter does give advance notice of events in school.
