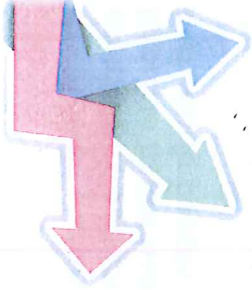

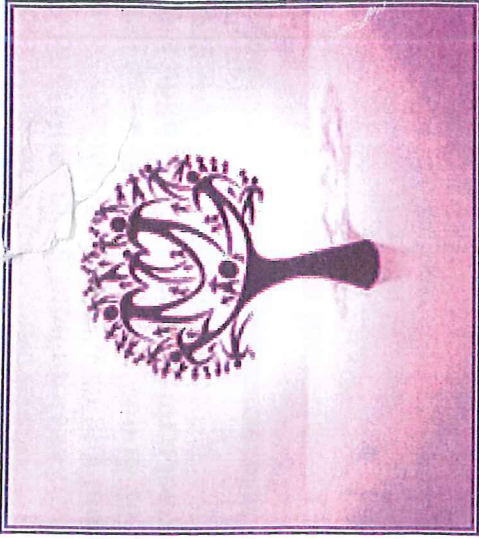

Who We Are:

Your Heanor Multi Agency Team is made up of staff from various professional backgrounds. We work with any family who has a child aged 0-19 (up to 25 years for a child/young person with a learning difficulty and/or disability).

Your team includes:

- Family Support Workers/Assistant
- Youth Workers
- School Attendance/Education Welfare Advice
- Personal Advisers/Employment Education and Training
- Children's Centre Staff (under 5's)
- Community Engagement and Volunteering

This service is provided by Derbyshire County Council Children Services/Early Help Offer in partnership with the Heanor and Langley Mill schools.

To deliver an effective service, we work alongside partner agencies including Health, Housing, Police and Social Care.

What We Do:

We provide support within the community and family's home to improve better outcomes for children and young people.

This includes group work, 1:1 support, parenting advice sessions and linking into a range of partner agencies.

The groups provided include:

- Lad's Lab (Boys & Young Men's Group)
- Girls & Young Women's Group
- Open Door Youth Club (Special Education Needs)
- The Crew Sixth Form Group
- Personal Health Social and Emotional Group
- Transition to Employment and Training
- Range of Children Centre Activities for under 5's
- Holiday Activities
