ENGLISH

Within our English lessons, we will be writing a character description and a diary entry inspired by our class reader. This will enable pupils to apply specific grammatical features relevant to year 6 and help develop effective editing skills.

Please encourage your child to read and learn their times tables at home. MyMaths homework will be set each Wednesday to be in for the following week.

Computing: Communication and Collaboration. In this unit, pupils explore how data is transferred over the internet. We will also reinforce how to communicate responsibly.

SCIENCE: 'Properties and Changes of Materials' is our area of study in which we will be exploring dissolving, separating mixtures and irreversible changes.
