This half term the children will be focusing on traditional tales and favourite stories. We start the half term with learning all about the season winter and then start our 'Tell me a Story' theme. The children will then choose their own favourite themes and stories leading up to the end of the half term. All the way through the half term the children will take part in different activities relating to our focus stories as well as stories of their own choosing.

We continue to learn about different celebrations throughout the year and this half term the children will be learning all about how people celebrate Chinese New Year - This year will be the year of the Snake

Snack in Nursery

All the children in nursery have access to snacks and water. We encourage the children to be independent with their snack time and can choose when they have snack and how much they have. The snack time area is a place where they can refuel, socialise with friends and show their independence skills in managing their eating habits.
