

Maths

Units this half term are a continuation of shape for our year 1 pupils. They will then move on to learning place value, finishing with addition and subtraction within 20.

Year 2 pupils will continue with their addition and subtraction unit, before moving on to a shape unit and finishing with their statistics unit."

History

Pupils will be learning about **Mary Anning**. We will look at what she discovered, where she made her discoveries and how her discoveries helped us to understand the past.

Science

This half term, the science unit is '**Seasons**.' We will be observing the changes across the 4 seasons focusing on the weather and how the day length varies. Mainly focussing on the winter season.

Computing

Pupils will be completing the unit '**Robot Algorithms**' this half term. This unit develops pupils' understanding of instructions in sequences and the use of logical reasoning to predict outcomes. Pupils will design algorithms and then test those algorithms as programs and debug them.

English

We will be learning all about dinosaurs and writing a fact file on a dinosaur for their end goal.

In year 1 pupils will sequence sentences to write short texts. Use capital letters to start sentences. Use full stops to end sentences. Use 'and' to join words,

In year 2 pupils will use conjunctions for time. Use expanded noun phrases to inform. Use commas to separate items in a list. Learn to proofread to correct.

Physical Education

Our PE units for this half term are '**Gymnastics**' and '**Dodgeball**'.

PE lessons are on **Monday and Thursday**.
