Rivers - topic homework ideas

Here are some suggestions:

- Art: Nico Klopp was an artist from Luxembourg who painted a lot of rivers. Have a go at painting your own river in the style of this famous artist.
- DT: Create a model of a river, from source to mouth. Can you label all of the different features too?
- Geography: Make your own map of the rivers in the UK or the local area. Take care to draw them accurately and label them neatly.
- Geography: Find the world's longest rivers on each continent and present your findings in a way of your choice.
- English: Write your own adventure story featuring a river. Make sure it has exciting events and lots of description to keep the reader engaged.
- English: Write a poem all about a river's journey. You could write an acrostic poem or design it in the shape of a river.
- PSHE: Design and make a poster about being safe in or around a river that can be shared with other children in school.

Or, why not try and create a quiz all about rivers to test your family?
