MISSING SO MUCH IN SCHOOL

It is so important that your child is in school every day. Please remember that if your child is not in school, they will miss so much of their learning and it is difficult to catch up. **If they are absent for one week, they will miss at least 25 lessons which cannot always be repeated.** We will follow up any concerns over attendance as it is so important that your child is in school as much as possible otherwise they cannot achieve their potential.



At 90% to 94% attendance, your child misses between 44 and 60 lessons over a year.

This is a huge amount of learning that is then missed by your child. Whilst we know that illness cannot be avoided sometimes, if the attendance of your child drops below 90%, the amount of learning that your child misses causes a real concern and it is a concern that Ofsted identified during our inspection.

However we are pleased that we do have a number of children who are achieving or are near to 100% attendance which will be celebrated.
